Registered 5K runners will receive a commemorative Irish t-shirt. Please come to the regular packet pick-up times at Sully's on Friday, March 20, from 5 to 7 or Saturday, March 21, from 7:30 to 9. We will give you your t-shirt and answer any questions regarding the virtual run/walk. If you know of someone that would still like to participate and get a t-shirt, please have them come to packet pick-up on Friday or Saturday and they can register for the virtual run/walk.

The Friendly Sons of St. Patrick are dedicated to putting on a running event that will be fun and worthwhile. We think that we have accomplished this with the virtual run/walk.
