Divisions

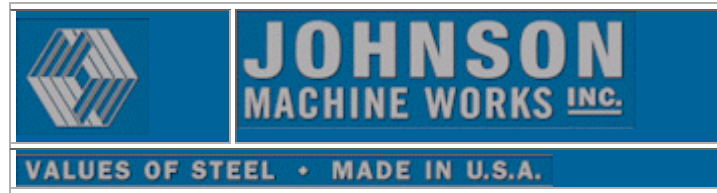
Each division will be divided into male and female with the following age divisions respectively:
